



# HEALTHWORKS COMMUNITY SMALL GRANTS

Georgia CEAL invites community-based organizations across the State of Georgia to apply for a HealthWorks Community Small Grant.



## ABOUT THE GRANTS

The HealthWorks Community Small Grants will be administered using a formal application and evaluation process through the MSM Prevention Research Center (PRC) and Georgia CEAL. Ten HealthWorks Community Small Grants will be awarded in the amount of \$15,000. These small grants will provide opportunities for community based organizations to leverage their local leadership to advance the goals of COVID-19 recovery by providing vaccine education, COVID-19 vaccinations and building vaccine confidence. Submitted proposals (no more than three pages excluding the budget) should address strategies and/or interventions on how the organizations will build infrastructure and improve the health status of Georgia residents. Activities and associated deliverables outlined in the proposal must address each of the following:

- Generating COVID-19 education, testing, vaccination and mitigation materials
- Hosting two co-sponsored COVID-19 forums with Georgia CEAL/HealthWorks
- Hosting COVID-19 vaccination events and activities with Georgia CEAL/HealthWorks
- Disseminating HealthWorks communications, events and materials
- Active participation at Georgia CEAL Community Coalition Board Meetings
- Submission of monthly activity reports to Georgia CEAL
- Submission of mid-reporting and end-reporting of a summary on lessons learned to Georgia CEAL
